

## Operator/Driver

If you are a self-motivated individual, who works well with others and are interested in developing a new career that offers growth, independence and travel, then this position is for you! This is a 100% travel position. Constant travel is required for up to three months at a time, with one week off.

IMS ([www.ims-rst.com](http://www.ims-rst.com)) - IMS is a growing consulting engineering firm with offices located in Arizona and Illinois. IMS collects and compiles pavement condition data and right of way asset information with a computerized vehicle that is equipped with specialized sensors and instruments. The field crew consists of three people, two are technicians and one is a crew chief. The technicians are responsible for the safe operation of the vehicle, collecting pavement distress and roadway features information and maintaining the vehicle. The operator/driver is responsible for driving the van and daily maintenance of the van. This is a position where organizational skills, effective communication and the ability to make the right decision at the right time are a must.

**This is a 100% travel position.** All field employees are required to travel throughout the United State and Canada for up to three months at a time, with scheduled days off depending on the workload. The crews stay in hotels paid for by the company. Each person has their own room and a daily allowance for meals. The crew typically works 40 to 60 hours per week, depending on the weather. A valid passport is required. You must be eligible for entry into Canada, and be able to meet their entrance requirements regarding any misdemeanor or criminal offenses.

No direct experience is required, as IMS will provide on the job training. The ideal candidate will bring to IMS the willingness to learn and lead others with a keen orientation to detail and quality of work. A professional appearance and the ability to interact with clients is a must! Candidates with backgrounds in data analysis, construction inspection, GIS, surveying, materials testing, engineering, or computers will generally have the necessary skills to excel in this work.

All employees are required to pass a drug test, have a background check, and have an excellent driving record. Driving violations for any of the following are not acceptable: 1) One or more major violations with the past five years, this includes: driving while intoxicated or impaired or under the influence of drugs; a criminal conviction; speed in excess of 25 MPH over the speed limit. 2) Cannot have 3 or more at fault accidents and/or moving violations in the past 3 years. 3) Cannot have 2 or more at fault accidents and/or moving violations in the past year. 4) No driving with a revoked license or reckless driving charges. 5) The individual cannot have any drug or alcohol related convictions.

There is a signing bonus after 3 months of employment.
